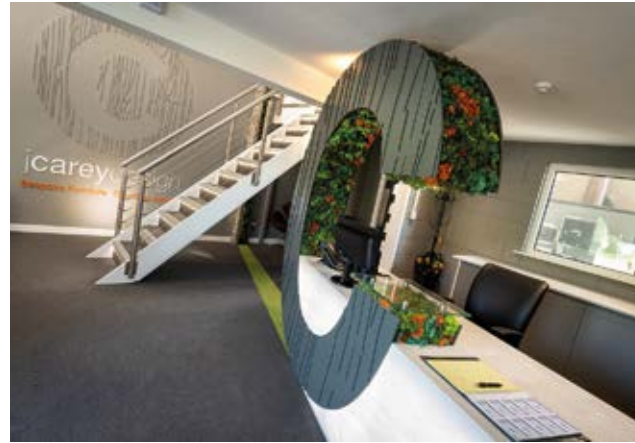

For this eclectic and bold design for a hotel in Manchester we manufactured a large number of bespoke items for the reception, communal and dining areas.

Co-ordination and collaboration with other trades was key in this long running London project. Every detail engineered to integrate seamlessly with the decorative work that followed.





In-house development of a bespoke patinaed brass finish gave this members' bar a unique look. This finish was applied to a range of brass tubes to create a stunning visual fascia, which will age and develop over time.



The user experience for this whisky distillery offers a journey through the whisky-making process. The feature wall below, built with authentic whisky barrels, required seamless integration with lighting, AV and moving parts.





Solid Oak fretwork panels, with window reveals, line the visitor bar alongside bespoke upholstered banquette seating.

The 3D Wall Panels below were manufactured with a 5-axis CNC, with hand-laid oak veneers applied to fire-rated MDF.

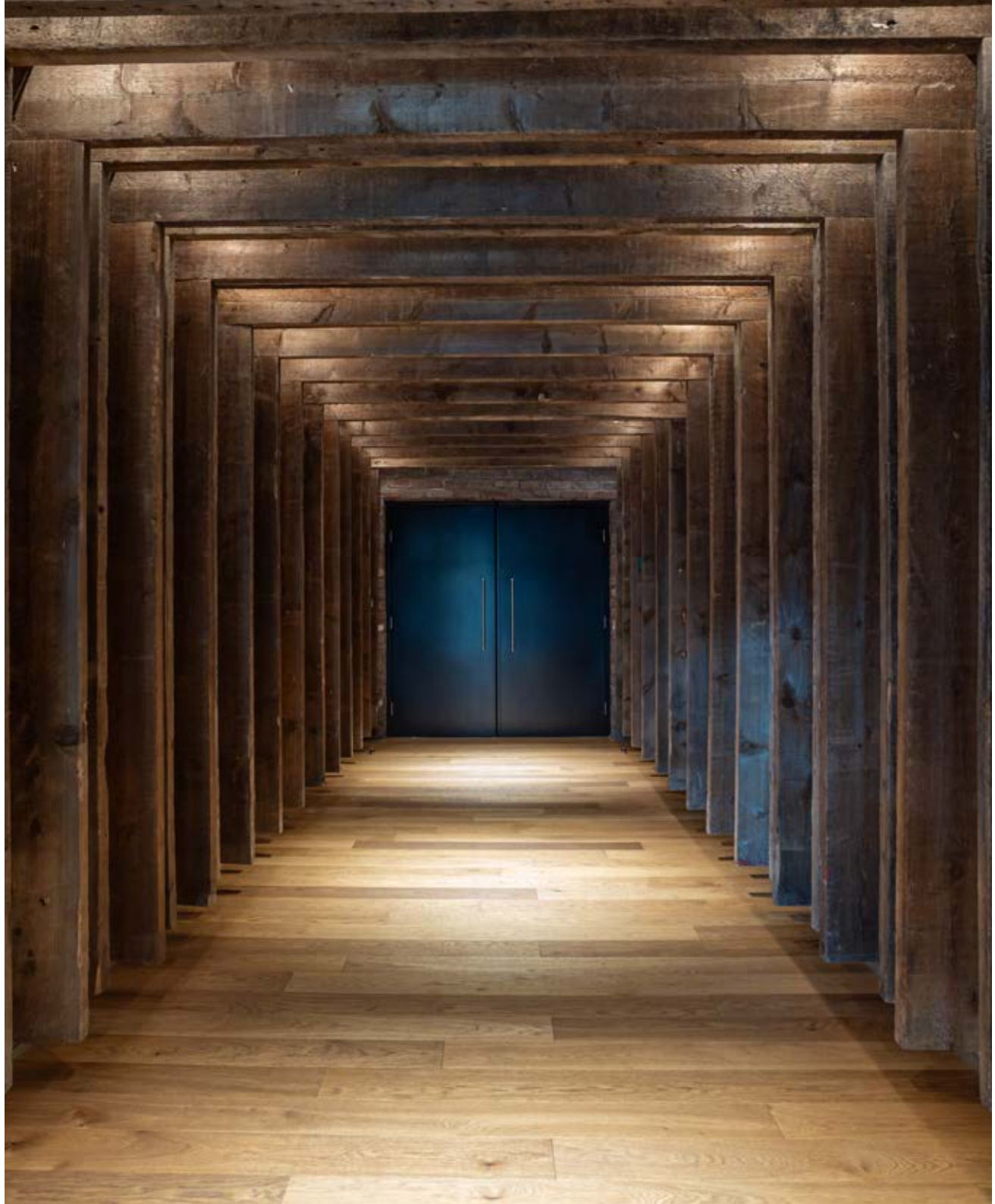


Extensive design development was undertaken to create an illusion of depth for the above Time Ring.





We reclaimed original timbers on site for specific use on this project. Over 2300 metres of timber were found, dried, reworked in-house and refitted on site.





Our team delivered a full suite of bespoke joinery and furniture for the retail fit-out, bar, dining areas and meeting rooms.

A complete new-build fit-out for a landmark hotel. Reception, bedrooms, bar dining, conference spaces and members' lounge. Appointed again, a decade after our first project for the client.



A full-scale mock-up of a bedroom, pre-build, was undertaken as part of our design and development offer. Every detail tested, perfected and approved before installation.

Beautifully detailed superloos and changing spaces that elevate guest comfort while meeting the functional demands of high-traffic leisure environments.

stadiums and hospitality



In total 18 individually themed bars and 2 serveries were amongst an array of fitted items within the new East Stand of this iconic stadium, the home of England Rugby®.



A wide variety of materials were used throughout this scheme including frosted reeded glass, deep veined carrera marble, blackened zinc bar tops and distressed corrugated steel.

To give an indication of the scale of bespoke joinery works undertaken, our package value exceeded £1.8 million.



Set over six floors the new stand provided in excess of 118,000 sq ft of hospitality and debenture space, for 6,800 premium ticket holders.



J Carey Design were on site for a very tight install period of three months, all works were completed on time and snag free for the start of the Autumn Internationals.

This image shows the commanding views from one of several corporate boxes we fitted out at a high profile Yorkshire sports venue.





Solid oak slats and veneer were prevalent throughout much of the scheme.



Over 4,000 individually cut pieces of Autex® (sound absorption material) were used to create this feature ceiling.

Durable changing facilities were installed for both the home and away teams.



This formed part of a much larger contract which included 16 private boxes, executive meeting rooms, bars, wall panelling, feature ceilings and doors, corporate reception and changing rooms.



In total over 630 dining tables were installed at this Premier League club's new stand. These included partners' lounges, and hospitality areas for executive, corporate, and private diners.



Solid oak, marble and laminate were all used in the manufacture of the various table-tops within this scheme.



Curved leather seating booths with an inset pipe, button and stitch detail were located in all of the executive areas.

Work was also undertaken in the home changing room with an intricate emblem being engraved into the ends of this central Corian® island unit.

Hidden speakers, integrated AV, acoustic panels and bespoke details are all designed and built to fit each individual cinema room perfectly.

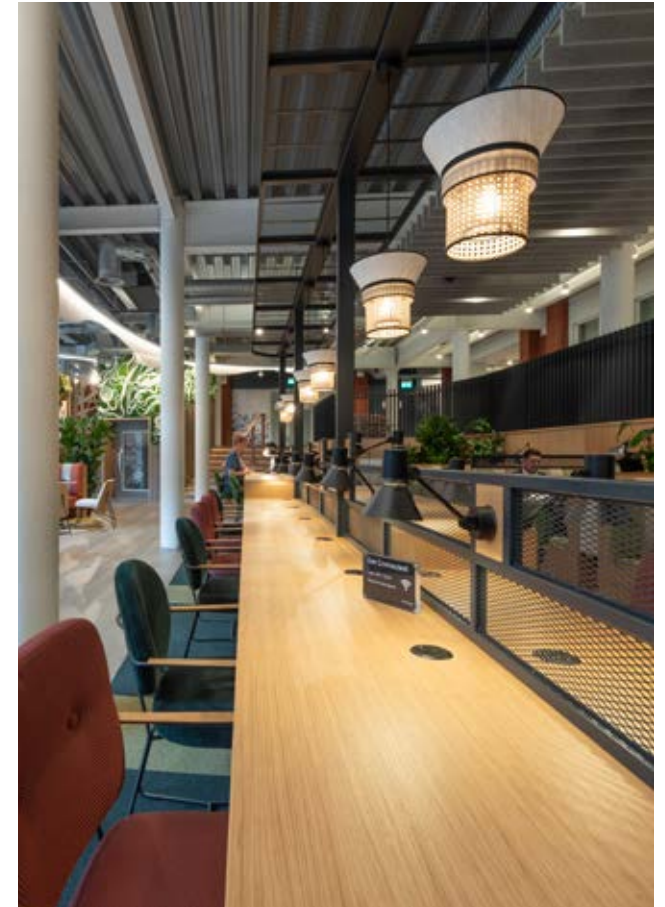

A vibrant co-working environment with a mix of social, collaborative, and functional spaces.



Our scope of works included structural screening, fret-cut decorative panelling, suspended planters, timber fins, and tiered seating with upholstery. A standout feature was the double-height space with a decorative wall incorporating a protruding seating booth.





An eco-friendly amenity space. Our extensive research, development and prototyping services helped bring to life the stunning lighting element shown here, from obtaining the right locally sourced sustainable tubes and precision machining them, through to suspension without movement.



In this multi-use event space with bar and meeting rooms, our work included tiered seating, a bar, and acoustic AV panels. For the office spaces, we manufactured kitchens with islands, break-out banquette seating, locker storage, planters and decorative display shelving.





Through proactive design development and early collaborative input, this scheme was delivered with full alignment between design intent, material quality, and commercial requirements.

Full specialist fit-out across two landmark workplace lobbies creating mirror-image schemes in two adjoining buildings. 100% bespoke and technically complex. Over 200m² of bronze-tinted, sandblasted glass lift lobby cladding was used on the project.

Using approximately 280 cubic ft of solid oak, these profiles were cut with custom made spindle moulding cutters to create a curved 12 metre long x 5 metre high timber bulkhead and wall cladding for a global law firm's reception.



Manufactured to accommodate bespoke inset LED strip lights. Finished in a custom-tint Euroclass B lacquer.



Full, high-end, flagship office bespoke furniture fit-out, with reception scheme, breakout locations, meeting pods, bespoke acoustic ceilings, and feature wall panels.

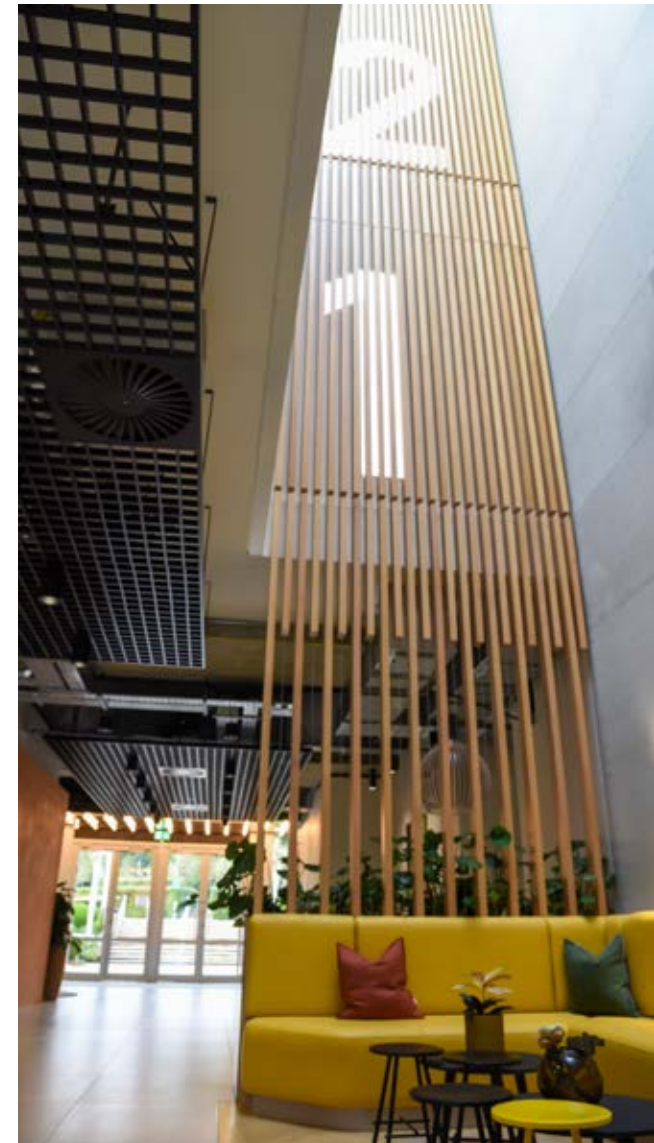

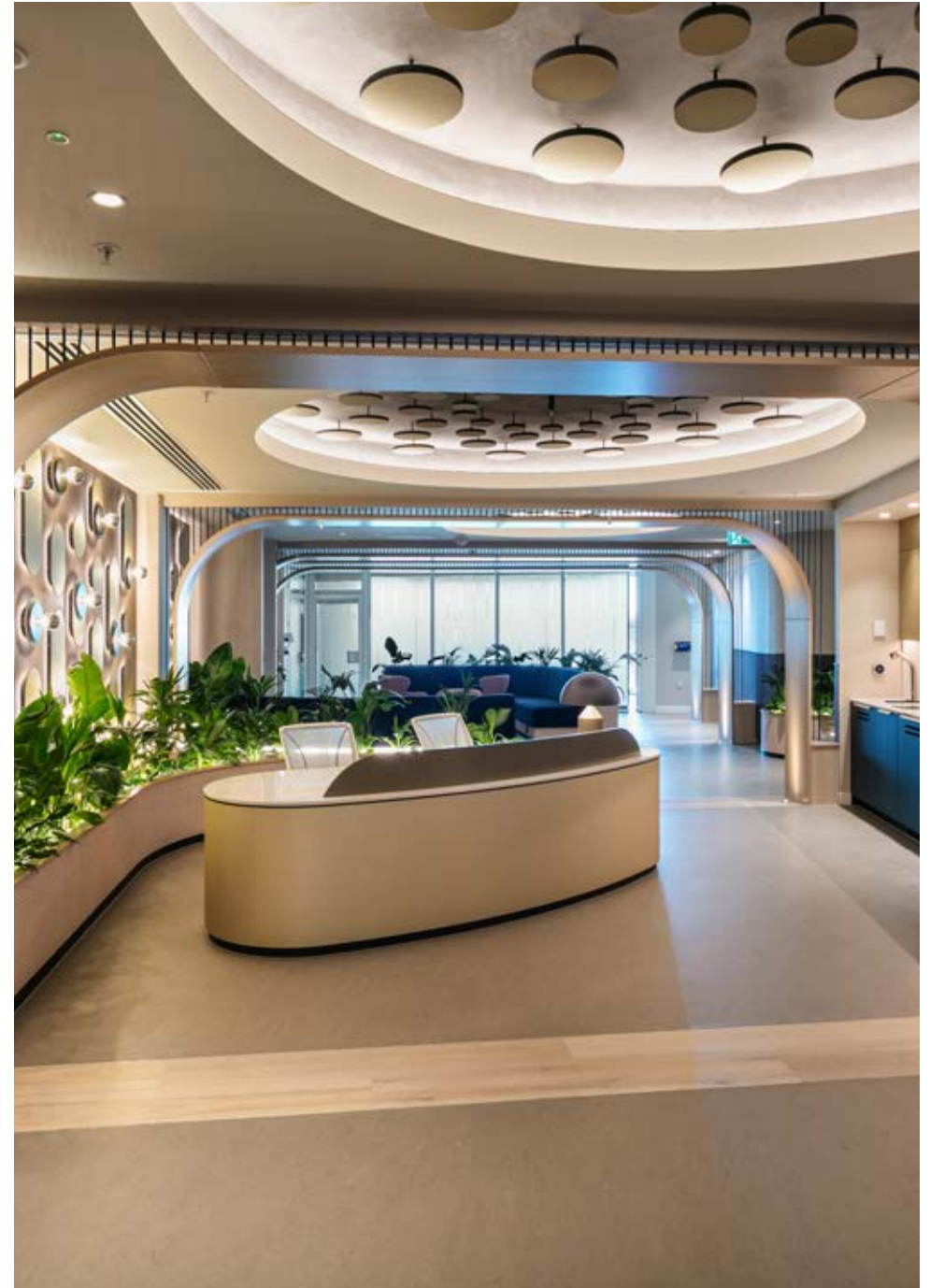

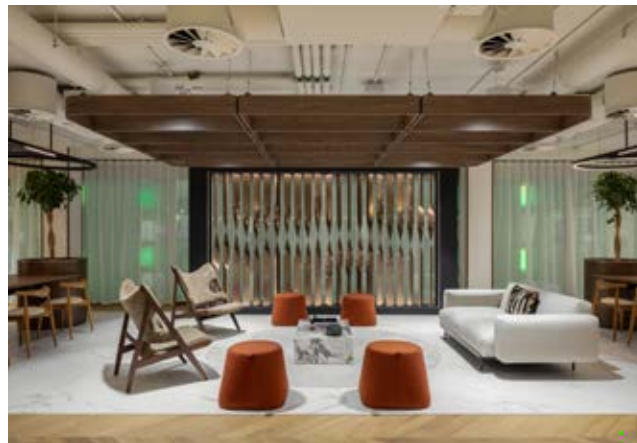

We carried out the design development and in-house manufacture of the ceiling rafts, and liquid metal-coated aluminium fins shown here.

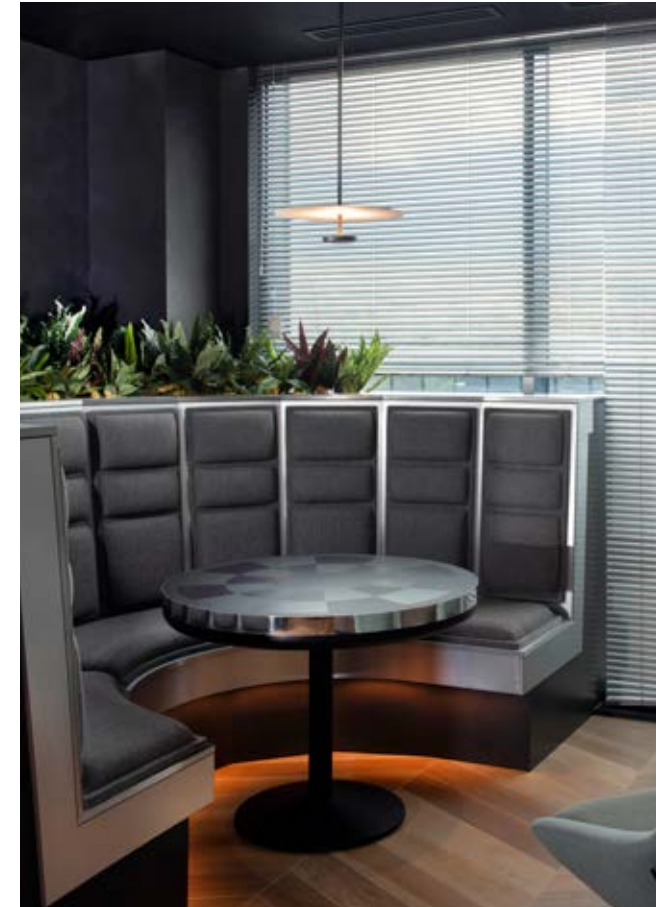

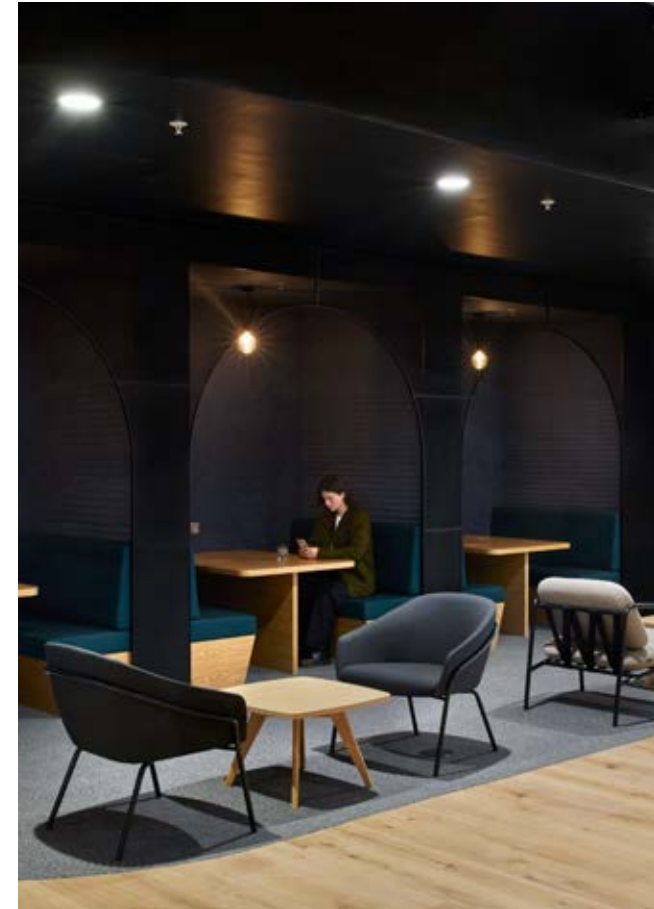


This project featured significant design development centred around a striking conical metal atrium planter. Considerable time was invested in the production of samples and mock-ups, and detailed coordination with multiple trades to bring the complex installation to life on site.



A unique environment inspired by the Millennium Falcon bridge, featuring custom upholstery and bespoke metal tables with applied graphic detailing.

A flagship building and workplace.
CAT A fit-out works included an impressive reception area, manufacture of a bespoke reception desk, podium, staircase balustrade and treads. Further CAT B work to the reception area included reception meeting booths and a large feature planter.





Following on from the initial landlord's fit-out the second phase of works involved the manufacture of a high volume of unique items. These included a 26-metre feature mesh ceiling track, serveries, tea points, breakout areas, decorative dividing walls, planters, upholstered seating and signage.

Our package included a statement reception desk, 8 custom AV walls, 16 architectural arches and 66 ceiling rafts of various design styles and finishes.

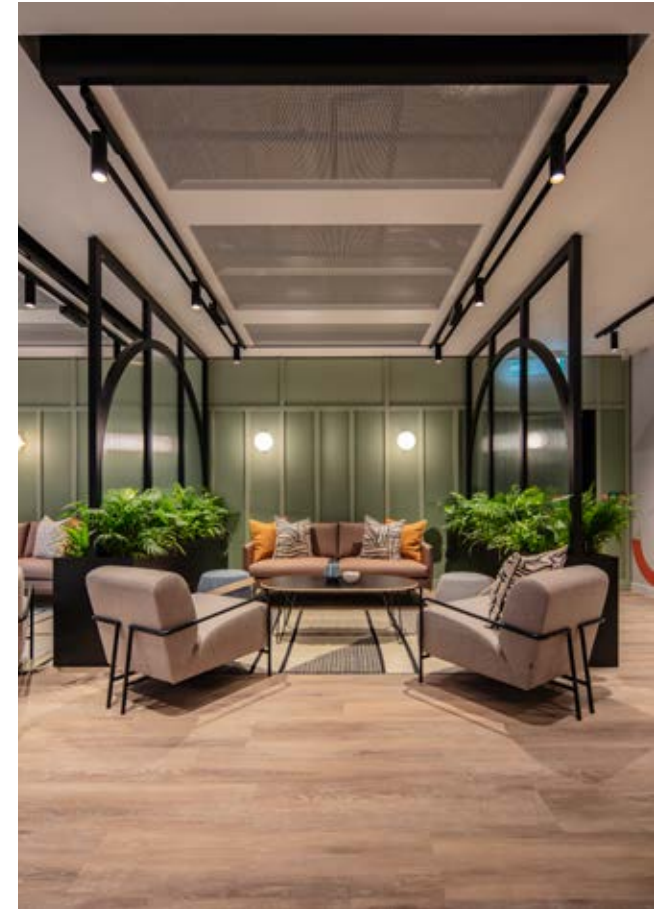
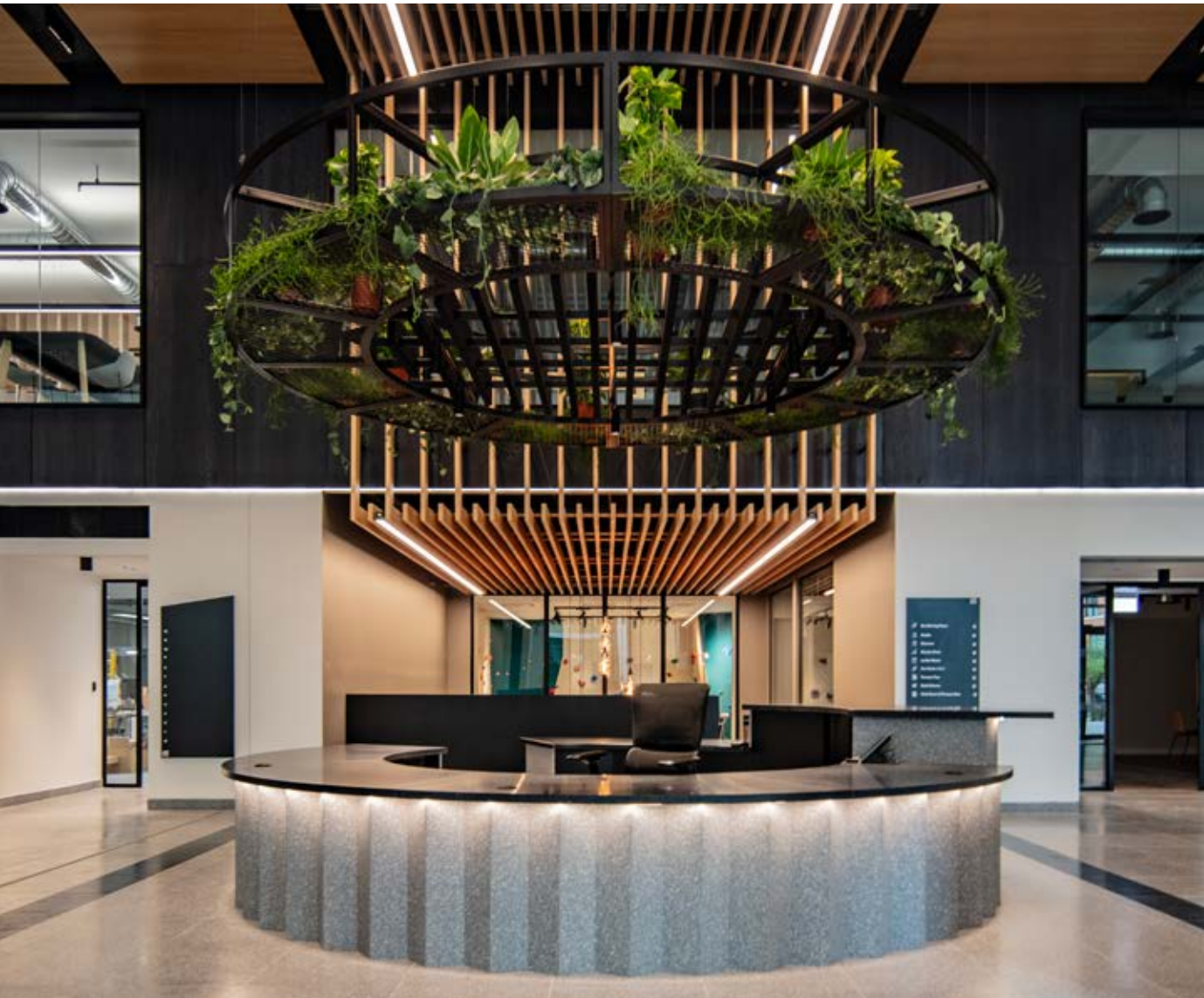
2 floors of bespoke joinery, ceilings and wall finishes integrated with mechanical, electrical and plumbing trades. Full high-end flagship office bespoke furniture fit-out.



Key features included bespoke latticework screens, bespoke upholstery, and an eye-catching wave feature wall covering.



Finishes on this project were carefully aligned with project aspirations and budget.



Landlord's fit-out works included an impressive double-height reception area with the design and manufacture of ceiling rafts, interior wall panelling, a bespoke reception desk, meeting booths, and joinery to 24 lift lobbies.

Terazzo cladding to this reception desk was undertaken on site.



Subsequent CAT B works involved the fit-out of the co-working space, including a second reception point, breakout areas, decorative dividing walls, and upholstered seating.

While much of our work sits subtly in the background, our scope in this vibrant workspace included staircase cladding, seating booths, integrated planters and a flexible presentation space.





Staircases are some of the most technically demanding elements we build. Structure, finish, compliance, detail: all need to come together perfectly. The quality of the joinery can make or break the final result.

Co-working and office space in London. A high-end bespoke joinery fit-out delivered across five floors in four phases. Specialist elements included phone booths with acoustic performance tested in-house, and joinery manufactured to very tight on-site tolerances.

This flagship facility combines state-of-the-art learning environments with public-facing social spaces. In addition to providing bespoke joinery to the amenity spaces, we clad the staircase with a bespoke CNC-cut oak-veneered board with a custom pattern, a cost-effective yet visually striking alternative developed during the VE process.

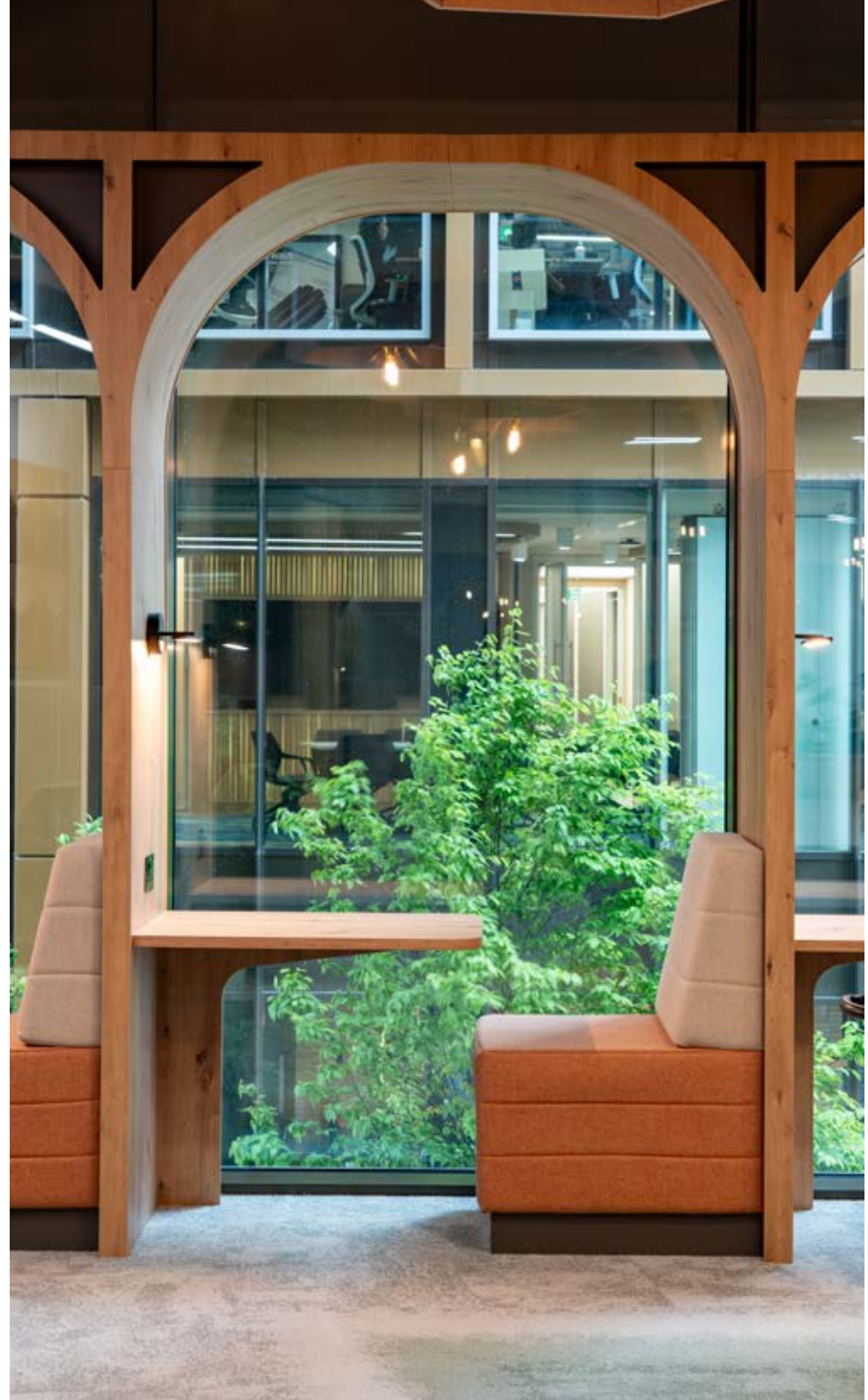
